

## Sports Premium Statement

### What is Sports Premium?

The government have pledged to provide additional funding of £150 million per annum over the next three academic years 2013/14, 2014/15 and 2015/16 to improve the provision of physical education (PE) and sport in primary schools. This funding provided jointly by the Departments for Education, Health and Culture, Media and Sport - will be allocated to primary school headteachers.

This funding is ring-fenced and therefore can only be spent on provision of PE and sport in schools.

Schools must spend the additional funding on improving their provision of PE and sport, but they will have the freedom to choose how they do this.

### How is Harby C of E Primary School using the Sports Premium?

Harby C of E Primary School has been allocated approximately £8350 through the Sports Premium funding.

After careful consideration it was decided that funding should be spent as follows in order to upskill teachers, improve resources and provision in order to improve the number of pupils who access quality physical activity:

- Funding staff development through approved quality training to develop teaching and subject knowledge in Physical Education aimed at all teachers and teaching assistants;
- To pay costs for hiring the sports hall at the Faith Mission and providing new resources to be kept onsite.
- To ensure that we compete in inter school competitions (both in partnership with Melton and Belvoir School Games and fixtures organised by Vale Schools family) by helping to fund transport costs;
- Enhance PE resources and equipment to include the use of ICT;
- To celebrate successes of individuals and teams in school;
- To offer a wider range of sporting experiences;
- To provide afterschool clubs to develop skills and participation and enhance opportunities already provided.

#### **The impact of this funding will be measured by:**

- Pupils more aware of peer assessment techniques to inform improvements in performances;
- Feedback by teachers to disseminate skills developed through training;
- Evaluation of the teaching of PE lessons leading to identification of future areas for development;
- Monitoring by PE Subject Leader of number of children accessing sporting activities and competitions.
