
The deadline for all applications is 31st October 2023. Everyone must apply for a place as there is not automatic entry for any school. Schools in the local area will be holding their own visit sessions and you can find out more information from specific schools by visiting their websites and we have included some of the dates Belvoir Priory Academy are holding in the forthcoming dates at the end of the Link Letter. Free School Meals / Food Vouchers

All children in Reception, Year 1 and Year 2 are entitled to Free School Meals - these are referred to as Universal Infant Free Meals. These are not means tested and are available to all children on roll. Since the Covid Pandemic the Local Authority have ensured that food vouchers are provided for pupils in receipt of Free School Meals during school holidays which has been of support to many families. This is only to pupils whose parents have completed the application form and are in receipt of Free School Meals that are means tested.
