



Belvoir Challenge 2025 – we need you!

The 2025 Belvoir Challenge will take place on Saturday 1st March and we need your help!

What is it?

The Belvoir Challenge is an annual 15 or 26 mile trail run / walk around the Vale Of Belvoir . It is run by the Friends of Harby School and is the school's only major fundraising event. Over £20,000 is raised every year and this pays for:

- School Trips
- Books
- Educational subscriptions
- Music and playground equipment

Every single child in the school benefits from the monies raised by the Challenge.

What can I do ?

Give us some of your time!

Over 800 runners and walkers take part in the Challenge each year. To enable this to happen we need people to volunteer their time on the weekend of the event. If one person from every family with a child at the school commits some time to the event this will enable it to continue for many more years, but if we don't have enough volunteers, it will no longer be

possible to run the event and the school's budget will be severely affected. Parents will then be asked to help make up this shortfall.

Any help is greatly appreciated – so whether you have an hour, or the whole day to offer, please let us know. Also, please feel free to rope in aunts, uncles, grandparents etc – everyone is welcome and the day itself is a great community event. Children are welcome to accompany parents for some roles on the day (e.g manning checkpoints) and love taking part. Many companies now offer employees a paid “charity day” to enable them to help out with fundraising events, so if this is the case with your employer please consider using your day to support us!

And finally.....

If you are thinking of running or walking the Challenge yourself, please reconsider and come and help out instead, as we need as many volunteers as possible and assisting on the day really is the best way you can support us.
