Year 6 visit to the Warning Zone

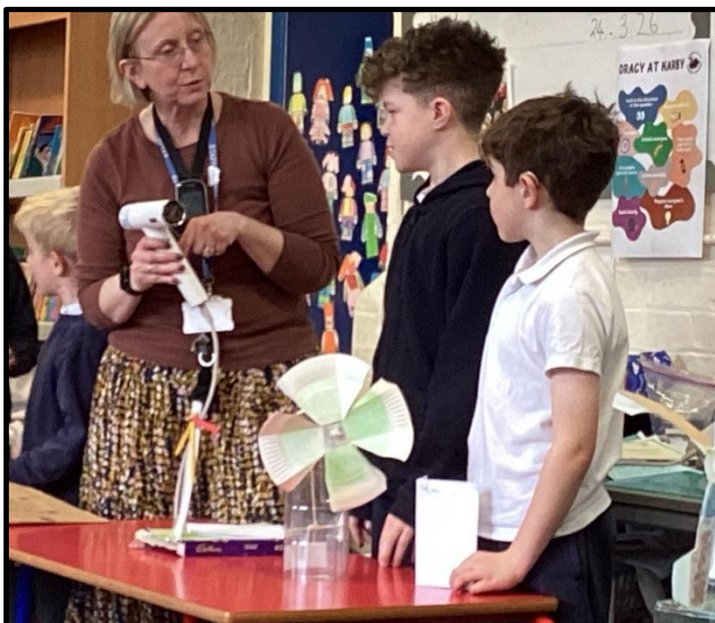
