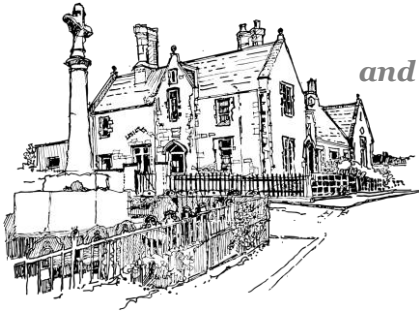

The evening performance is for adults and older children only and there will be refreshments after the play, supported by the Friends of the School.

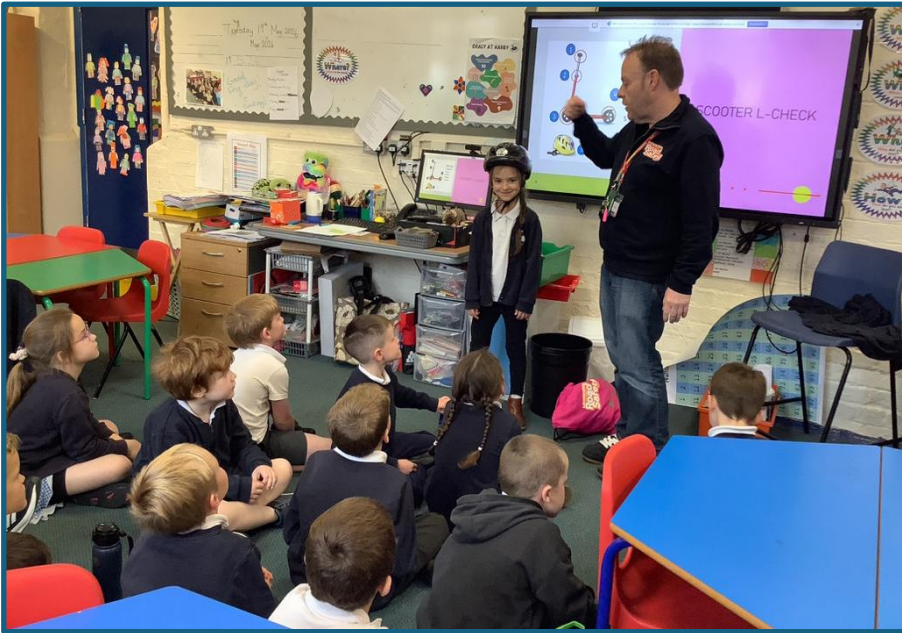
