Class 3's end of year play

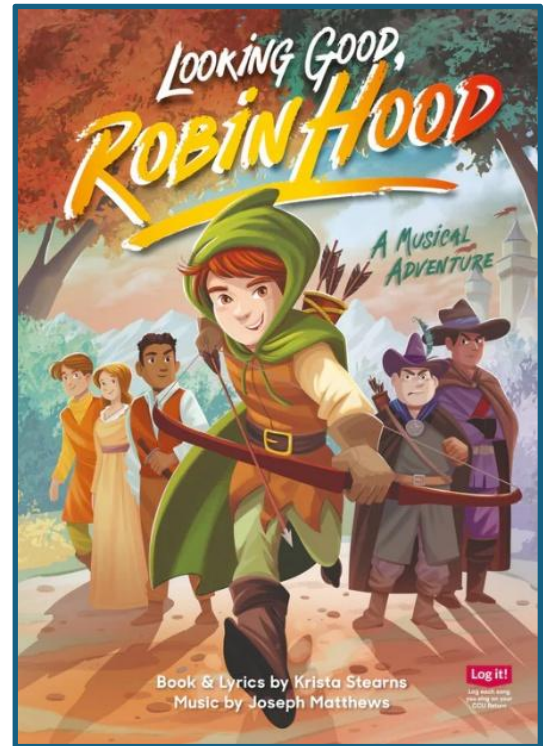
Class 3 have been busy with rehearsals for their end of year play, 'Looking Good, Robin Hood.'
