




Harvest Festival

Data Collection Forms

We have reissued Data Collection forms this week. These are very important to enable us to keep up to date with contact details, at least 3 emergency contacts and any medical needs your child may have so that we can offer appropriate support in school. Please check the details, amend as necessary and return to the school office. Thank you for the forms we have received back so far. Applying for Secondary School Places

If your child is currently in Year 6 you will need to apply for their secondary school place for when they transfer from primary. The Leicestershire County Council website has information which can be found at https://www.leicestershire.gov.uk/education-and-children/schools-colleges-and-academies/school-admissions/apply-for-a-secondary-school-place and you may find this useful.

The deadline for all applications is 31st October 2023. Everyone must apply for a place as there is not automatic entry for any school. Schools in the local area will be holding their own visit sessions and you can find out more information from specific schools by visiting their websites and we have included some of the dates Belvoir Priory Academy are holding in the forthcoming dates at the end of the Link Letter. New School Dinner Menus

We are very excited about our move to Coombs as our new school dinner provider from 1st October. From 1st October until half term we will follow the old menu, just for these two weeks, but meals will be produced by Coombs. After half term we will be moving onto our new menu. This will be a 3-weekly rotation with a main, vegetarian and jacket potato option every day.



This menu will change after Christmas and again after Easter. We are excited that this will offer all children a much wider variety of choice! We have shared the menu with parents via email this week for you to have a look at.

Free School Meals / Food Vouchers

All children in Reception, Year 1 and Year 2 are entitled to Free School Meals - these are referred to as Universal Infant Free Meals. These are not means tested and are available to all children on roll. Since the Covid Pandemic the Local Authority have ensured that food vouchers are provided for pupils in receipt of Free School Meals during school holidays which has been of support to many families. This is only to pupils whose parents have completed the application form and are in receipt of Free School Meals that are means tested. 
